



Terms & Conditions of Membership

Membership

Membership is non-refundable and by becoming a member of Liverpool Catholic Club I agree to abide by the Club's Constitution, and I understand the terms and conditions of entry to the Club. I also confirm I am over the age of 18 years old, and I am willing to provide proof of age as a condition of entry and acceptance into the venue.

Information Collection/Use

Liverpool Catholic Club is subject to Provisions of the Privacy Act 1988. The Act contains 10 National Privacy Principles that set standards for the handling of personal information.

Liverpool Catholic Club has a commitment to privacy and the safeguarding of member, visitor and staff personal information. Any personal information provided by you to Liverpool Catholic Club (eg name, address, date of birth and contact details), including information collected as a result of membership card being placed in a gaming machine or other club machine that is linked to a member loyalty system (not ATMs) that may provide a benefit or service to you, will be protected.

Liverpool Catholic Club does not usually disclose your personal information to any other organization or person unless there is legal requirement to do so. Liverpool Catholic Club may also disclose personal information to relevant authorities if it reasonably believes that there is a threat to an individual's life, health or safety, or public health or safety. If Liverpool Catholic Club has reason to suspect that unlawful activity has been, is being or may be engaged in, personal information may be used or disclosed as a necessary part of any investigation and reporting to relevant persons or authorities.

Liverpool Catholic Club may disclose your information to third parties that provide services under contract to Liverpool Catholic Club. These contracts require the third party to keep your personal information confidential and secure.

Liverpool Catholic Club may collect personal information in order to comply with obligations under the Anti-Money Laundering and Counter Terrorism Financing Act. The personal information collect will be kept secure at all times and only passed on to external bodies if required or authorised by law.

Your personal information, including information about you obtained as a result of you placing your membership card in a gaming or other Club machine (not ATMs), may be used by Liverpool Catholic Club for marketing purposes to improve our services and to provide you with the latest information about those services, any new related services and promotions.

If you do not wish to receive information about services and promotions Liverpool Catholic Club, on request, will remove your name from mailing lists. You have the right to access any personal information that Liverpool Catholic Club may hold about you, including a right of correction of your information. Liverpool Catholic Club will generally not charge a fee for you to access your personal information.

QUALIFICATIONS, RIGHTS AND ENTITLEMENTS OF CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP:

The qualifications, rights and entitlements of members are set out in the Club's Articles of Association. Set out below is a summary of those qualifications, rights and entitlements.

Voting members: Only persons who are over the age of 18 years and are Catholic are eligible to be elected to Voting membership of the Club.

Voting members are entitled to:

- i. Attend and vote at all general meetings of the Club and vote in the election of the Board or any member or the Board;
- ii. Vote on any Special Resolution including any Special Resolution to amend the Memorandum and Articles of Association;
- iii. Subject to Articles 39(d) and 40 of the Club's Articles of Association, stand for election to the Board;
- iv. Nominate or second any candidate for election to the Board;
- v. Use all the social and sporting amenities and facilities of the Club.

Social Members: Only persons who are over the age of 18 years are eligible to be elected to Social membership of the Club.

Social members are entitled to:

- a. Attend at all general meetings of the Club; and
- b. Use all of the social and sporting amenities and facilities of the Club.

However, Social members are not entitled to:

- i. Vote at any general meeting of the Club or vote in the election of the Board or any member of the Board; or
- ii. Stand for election to the Board;
- iii. Nominate or second any candidate for election to the Board.

Junior members: Only persons who are under the age of 18 years are eligible to be elected to Junior Membership of the Club. A person shall not be admitted as a Junior member unless the Board:

- a. Is satisfied that the person is joining the club for the purposes of taking part in sporting activities organised by the Club or a sporting subclub of the Club;



- b. Has received from that person's parent or guardian written consent to that person becoming a Junior member of the Club and taking part in the sporting activities organised by the Club or a sporting sub-club of the Club;
- c. Is satisfied that that person will take part in regular sporting activities organised by the Club or a sporting sub-club of the Club.

Subject to the provisions of the Registered Clubs Act, Junior members are entitled to the use of such of the facilities of the Club as the Board shall

determine from time to time but are not entitled to:

- i. Attend or vote at any general meetings of the Club; or
- ii. Stand for election to the Board;
- iii. Nominate or second any candidate for election to the Board.
